Dear Commander and FOIA Compliance Officer:

This letter is a request pursuant to 5 U.S.C. Sec. 522, The Freedom of Information Act. I request a copy of the Union County PAS Tyger River Dam project report.

As you are well aware, this is a project funded with taxpayer funds involving Federal lands and waters and subject to the FOIA. The project should have been completed over a year ago and voluntary requests for the study have been ignored. It would be unacceptable should you claim this to be a draft and not available in that it has been released to the public through the release to Union County.

As to the assessment of fees pursuant to FOIA, I would ask that they be waived in that I am a writing to you as a concerned citizen and pro bono representative of the South Carolina Native Plant Society and other interested South Carolinians.

The purpose of the request is non-commercial with the intent to educate and inform the public as to the actions of the Corp related to this project.
